### Waste Management Services

Adelaide Plains Council has entered into a contractual arrangement with Solo Resource Recovery to provide Kerbside Waste Collection Services.

As of Monday 5 February 2018 Solo Resources, on behalf of Council, will commence this service. Residents will not see any changes to the servicing of their bins - collection days and bin sizes will remain the same. Solo Resources will collect bins every weekday, inclusive of Public Holidays, with the exception of Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Residents will see a different truck emptying bins. The truck will be bright green, branded with both Council and Solo's logos.



Commencing from Monday 5 February 2018, residents requiring assistance with missed, broken or stolen bins are to contact Solo Resource Recovery for action – phone **1300 GO SOLO** or **1300 46 7656**.

Adelaide Plains Council Mayor Tony Flaherty said: - *“The outsourcing of waste management services will result in reduced costs which our ratepayers will see as a reduced waste charge in next year’s rate notice.”*

Before 1 July 2018, current bins will be exchanged for bins with changed lid colours that conform to KESAB’s standards. The new bin lids will be hot stamped with information of items that can be disposed off in each bin.

The new bins to be provided to residents will be:-

- YELLOW lid bin for recycling
- RED lid bin for Household Domestic
- GREEN lid bin for Organics and Green Waste

Adelaide Plains Council will provide more information to residents as to how the bin exchange program will be implemented closer to the rollout.
